What is adaptive golf?

Spaulding Cape Cod's adaptive golf programs are designed to assist persons of all ages with disabling conditions return to, or learn to play, the game of golf. It is appropriate for those with physical limitations due to arthritis, stroke, hip or knee surgery, amputation, paraplegia, and any other physically limiting illness or injury. Spaulding Cape Cod has two SoloRider adaptive golf carts to assist paraplegics, quadriplegics and amputees in accessing the course and the greens.



Back in the Swing (BITS)

Back in the Swing consists of three 2-hour sessions at local golf courses with the following lesson plan:

Week 1: Work with specially-trained rehabilitation staff on grip, stance, and swing. There will be an emphasis on fundamentals and safety.

Week 2: Continue to work on adaptive methodologies tailored to your needs.

Week 3: Play a few holes of golf with the assistance of Spaulding Cape Cod rehabilitation staff and adaptive equipment as needed.

Back on Course (BOC)

Back on Course is designed for Back in the Swing graduates who want to take the next step in getting back on the golf course. This is a one-day course during which participants play 9 holes of golf with the assistance of staff and adaptive equipment as needed.

Adaptive Golf FAQ:

1. Pre-registration and participant telephone interviews are required for all Spaulding Cape Cod adaptive golf programs so that we are fully informed of each individual's needs with regard to staffing and equipment.
